Part 1
Juniata CATV

§101. Grant of Authority. Walker Township, herein referred to as Grantor, hereby grants to Juniata CATV, the right and privilege from the effective date of agreement entered into between Grantee and Township to construct, maintain, and operate in the present and future streets, alleys, and public places of the Township of Walker, towers, poles, lines, cables, necessary wiring, and other apparatus for the purpose of receiving, amplifying, and distributing television and radio signals to said Township and the inhabitants thereof. §102. Conditions of Street Occupancy.

1. Poles and towers shall be so erected as not to interfere with the traffic over the streets, alleys, and public places, and the location of all poles, towers, or other obstructions shall be fixed with the prior written approval and under the supervision of the Township Supervisors, as to such location giving consideration to the reasonable operation of the system; providing further that such location shall not be a vested interest, and the same shall be removed by Grantee whenever the same restrict or obstruct the operation or location of said streets, alleys, and public places.

2. Permission is hereby granted to Grantee to attach or otherwise affix cables, liens, or wires to the pole facilities of any public utility company even though the same may cross over the streets, sidewalks, public lands, and highways of the Township of Walker, provided the Grantee secures the permission and consent of said public utility company concerned to affix the cables, lines, or wires or other apparatus to their pole facilities.

§103. Safety Requirements. Grantee shall maintain all towers, poles, lines, cables, necessary wiring, and other apparatus in good and safe condition, according to reasonable safety standards in the industry. (Ord. 6/6/1966, 6/6/1966, §4)

§104. Repairs. All streets, sidewalks, and rights of way disturbed or damaged in the construction or maintenance of said cable lines and other appurtenances shall be promptly repaired by the Grantee at Grantee's expense and to the satisfaction of the Township. (Ord. 6/6/1966, 6/6/1966, §5)

§105. Compliance with Applicable Laws and Ordinances. Grantee shall be subject to all ordinances now in force or that may be hereafter enacted relative to the use of the streets, alleys, or public places of the Township. (Ord. 6/6/1966, 6/6/1966, §6)

§106. Assignability. Right, interest, or privilege granted or vested in this Part 1 to Grantee shall be assigned, transferred, or granted to any assignee or transferee with the prior approval of the Township Board of Supervisors. (Ord. 6/6/1966, 6/6/1966, §7)

§107. Exclusive Franchise. The grant of any and all rights, interests, and privileges under this Part 1 shall constitute an exclusive franchise or privilege to Grantee. (Ord. 6/6/1966, 6/6/1966, §8)

§108. Indemnification of Municipality. Grantee shall indemnify and save and hold harmless Township of, from and against any and all liabilities, losses, damages, suits, claims, demands, charges, costs and expenses, including counsel fees which Township may suffer, sustain, or in any way be subjected to resulting from or arising out of the construction, maintenance, or operation of the said poles, towers, lines, and other appurtenances. §109. Authority of President of Board of Township Supervisors. The President of the Board of Township Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute any and all agreements necessary to carry out the provisions of this Part 1. (Ord. 6/6/1966, 6/6/1966, §11)
