

February 2, 2009

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, February 2, 2009 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the January 5, 2009 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved.

**Visitors present:** Steve Becker, Harry Becker, Mrs. Kristen Kunkel-Zimmerman, Gloria Stuck, Roxann McGinnis, Rufus Peachey, John D. Wengerd, Becky Leiter, Bob Shick, and Tom Leiter.

Harry and Steve Becker were visiting. Mrs. Kunkel-Zimmerman was present to discuss her mother's house located in Mexico. She wants to tear down the existing house and put a modular home on a permanent foundation in the same location. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve this request. Ms. Stuck and Ms. McGinnis from CJEMS reported on the 2008 activity in Walker Township. They answered 61 calls in the township. Mr. Peachey and Mr. Wengerd were present to request an occupancy permit to operate a dog kennel. The property is located in the Rural Ag district, which permits such activity. Shirley Saner will issue the permit and send a copy of the ordinance and permit with the applicant to send to the state. Mrs. Leiter, Bob Shick and Tom Leiter (Mifflintown Hose Co) were present to update the Supervisors on their 2008 activities.

**PERMITS:** By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as issued by Shirley Saner: John Wengerd (Occupancy), Ethan Good (Extension), James Kint, Urie Petersheim and Rufus Peachey (Occupancy). Mrs. Saner, also, reported the Zoning Hearing Board will meet on February 17, 2009 to rule on the Davis campground request.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the PennDot EALA resolution to allow Year-end reports to be filed electronically.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the following fees for the tax collector: Tax Certification - \$5.00, Duplicate Bill fee - \$5.00 and Returned Check charge - \$5.00 plus Bank Charge.

By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the addition of the Baney Farm to the Walker Township AgSecurity Area.

**SUBDIVISIONS:** By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following subdivisions: David Moist and Charles Saner.

**NEW BUSINESS:** By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to change/correct the names of several streets due to a conflict caused by the 911 addressing. The changes are as follows: Chicken Plant Rd to W River Rd, Buzz Plant Rd to Cunningham Rd, Spelling changes to Kauffman Hill Rd, Wengerd Rd, and Colyer Rd, Redefine the following roads in Mexico - Mexico Heights Rd, Henry St, Colyer St and Foster St, E River Rd and Hopple St.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 9454 through 9483 and 567 from Mexico Street Light fund.

By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 9:15 pm.
