

May 3, 2010

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, May 3, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Dreibelbis and Casner were also present. The minutes of the April 5, 2010 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved.

VISITORS: None

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as issued by Mrs. Saner: Clarence Allen, Steven Leach, Michael Leister, Urie Wengerd, Stephen Petersheim, and Tom Wagner.

DAVIS UPDATE: None presented

OLD BUSINESS: None presented.

PARK UPDATE: Sand Mound and electric pad laid out, Port-o-Pots moved, installed doors, set trusses, metal roof in place, reset home plate (F1) and seeded new drain.

Mr. Casner motioned that Little League has exclusive rights to Field 3 from March 15 to June 15th every year unless there are open dates. Mr. Shearer seconded the motion then withdrew his second. Motion failed due to lack of a second.

NEW BUSINESS: Road construction bids were received from the following companies: Glenn O Hawbaker Inc. (\$56,179.95), Eastern Industries (\$54,296.00) and Jay Fulkroad & Sons (\$49,487.87). The bids were opened at 7:50 pm by all three supervisors. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to accept the Jay Fulkroad & Sons bid in the amount of \$49,487.87. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to apply for the Township's county aid allocation of \$4,166.01 to be applied to the 2010 road construction project.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve Nancy Baillie as the Applicant Agent for the 2010 snowstorm reimbursement.

By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried the purchase of an upgrade to QuickBooks 2010 was approved. Intuit will no longer service QB 2007 payroll thus an upgrade is necessary.

The Walker Township Planning Commission approved the requested change from Single Family Residential to Industrial Commercial for the Robert Wright property located on William Penn Hwy. A copy of the request will be sent to the County Planning Commission.

The Township received a letter signed by all adjoining property owners of the proposed Juniata Lumber & Supply, Inc. development stating they agree with the no side yard requirements of the Zoning Ordinance Chapter 27, section 805, 3A. Mr. Dreibelbis would like a recommend a letter be written to the Engineer to allow a 10 foot property setback be considered.

SUBDIVISIONS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the Betty Wirt subdivision. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the David K Deamer subdivision.

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 9981 through 10006 and 582 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$1,382.92 was approved for payroll taxes.

By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 9:10 pm.
