February 9, 2011 Meeting Minutes

The Walker Township Recreation Board met on Wednesday, February 9 2011 at the Walker Township Municipal Building. Present: Paul Baker, Martin Dreibelbis, Perry Shellenberger, Bruce Righter and Nancy Baillie. Absent: None. Paul Baker called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Visitors: Brian Strawser.

The minutes of the January 12, 2011 meeting were reviewed and approved as presented.

The treasurer's report – As of January 31, 2011, the treasurer reported the following: **Income:** Interest - \$38.83, and **Expenses:** \$23.39 (rakes), \$41.00 (fuel to pick up stoves) and \$2,301.72 (building construction).

Old Business: None.

New Business: The following items were completed from January 13, 2011 to February 7, 2011: FRP installed in Ladies' restroom, door installed, the building was cleaned up, and the ceiling was installed in the restroom entry and ½ of the pavilion ceiling. The restroom partitions were ordered and should be here next week. The board reviewed 2010 park expenses. Marty received a price on the sand mound installation of \$3,000 (machine time and 3 days labor). Also, he received a price on the septic and dousing tanks installation of \$2,400.

Next week the following will be worked on: ceiling, install louvers, install knobs, covers placed on receptacles and hang the exit/emergency lights.

Concession stand committee: The committee met at the park on January 24, 2011.

Field use request: Brian Strawser requested the soccer field in the months of April and May. This will be for 4 Saturdays for his Blue Wave Girls soccer team. By motion of Perry and seconded by Marty and carried the request was approved.
