

May 4, 2009

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, May 4, 2009 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the April 6, 2009 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved.

Visitors present: NONE

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as submitted by Mrs. Saner: Matthew Swartz, Calvin Trimble JR, Extensions to Joe Tabb of JCSD and Vanessa Goodling.

OLD BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the Park Rules and Regulations as submitted by the Recreation Park Board.

PARK UPDATE: Bases were installed on 4/18, a spike drag was built, the finish drag and limer have arrived, building plans were submitted to Commonwealth Code on 4/23/09, Infields were sprayed, Fertilizer was applied, the dumpster and handicapped port-o-pot have been delivered. Mr. Dreibelbis contacted Senator Specters office and SEDA COG concerning funds from the stimulus package – none available to fund parks and recreation.

NEW BUSINESS: Bids for the 2009 road construction project were opened at 7:45 pm. By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to accept the bid from Jay Fulkroad and Sons in the amount of \$82,610.60. Other bids received: Eastern Industries - \$87,877.00 and Glenn O Hawbaker - \$84,792.90. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to apply the county aid funds in the amount of \$4,832.43 to this project.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to change the following road names as requested by residents: Colyer St to Autum St and Hambright Lane to Fossil Lane.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to purchase the new road signs from Chemung. Bids were, also, received from US Municipal Supply and PA Dept of Corrections.

By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to send the Port Royal EMS a 1,000 donation as budgeted.

The Davis's have decided to appeal the Zoning Hearing Board decision concerning their campground project. The Township will have to find another lawyer since Mr. Zimmerman is doing unrelated work for the Davis family. The appeal will be taken to the Common Pleas Court, date not known at this time. Mr. Dreibelbis will contact Jeff Snook and Karen Hackman to see if they would be willing to represent the Township.

SUBDIVISIONS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the Wade Guisbert Subdivision. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the Eli Troyer Right of Way. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the Edward Auker/James Kint lot addition subject to changing the deed notice.

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 9562 through 9592 and 570 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$771.42 was approved for payroll taxes. A hold was put on the L/B Water and Deihl's Excavation checks pending a review of the purchased pipes.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 9:10 pm.
