

June 1, 2009

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, June 1, 2009 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the May 4, 2009 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved.

Visitors present: Mr. Bowsman.

Mr. Bowsman was present to express concern over a piece of property with deed restrictions. According to Mr. Bowsman the piece of property is owned by Mrs. Donna Milliken and is not to be not further subdivided nor have a mobile home placed on said property. He wanted to know if the township would stop it from being subdivided. The Supervisors do not look at the deeds when approving/disapproving subdivision plans; they only look at compliance of the Township Subdivision/Zoning ordinance.

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as submitted by Mrs. Saner: Craig Maben and Joseph Hoke.

OLD BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the Chemung Guide Rail Contract. Chemung will supply and install the guide rail on Swamp Rd at a cost of \$2,450.00. Other telephone estimates were received from Keystone Guide rail for \$3,725.00 and Matt Kenepf of Penn Dot for \$3,625.00.

PARK UPDATE: May 24 - The fields were raked and cleared of all grass clippings, May 25 – the fields were sprayed for weed control, Marty and Paul met with Vic Cramer concerning the building, the building plans for the new building were approved by CCIS.

NEW BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to name the following lane as requested by residents: lane beside the Jones house to Walnut Drive.

Mr. Dreibelbis contacted Karen Hackman concerning the Davis appeal. He was told the case would sit at the Common Pleas Court until Mr. Winder pursues it. The Township should wait for a court hearing date. Mr. Zimmerman sent a letter to all the townships he represents concerning the UCC Board of Appeals. He is trying to set up an Inter-municipal Agreement with a number of municipalities. The Supervisors agreed to participate in the Agreement to form a COG for the purpose of establishment of a Board of Appeals.

SUBDIVISIONS: NONE

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 9593 through 9633 and 571 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$2,043.06 was approved for payroll taxes. A hold was put on the Deihl's Excavation check pending an itemized bill.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to transfer \$30,000 from the State Fund Money Market to the State Fund Certificate of Deposit for 12 months.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 9:00 pm.
