

October 5, 2009

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, October 5, 2009 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Dreibelbis were also present. The minutes of the September 8, 2009 meeting were read by the Secretary and approved by motion of Mr. Casner and seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried.

Visitors present: Gerald Landis, Scott Eimerbrill and Becky Leiter (Mifflintown Hose Co). Mr. Landis and Mr. Eimerbrill were present to ask if a trailer may be moved back onto a piece of property owned by Mr. Landis. Previously, a trailer occupied by Mrs. Brown and was removed when she moved. This property already has a house located on it. Since the property has its own septic system and well, it would be ok to place a trailer back on the property if the SEO checks the system and finds it in good working condition. Becky Leiter was present to answer any questions and to invite the Supervisors to their meeting scheduled for October 21, 2009.

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as submitted by Mrs. Saner: Donna Stoner, Benjamin Petersheim, Richard Kepner and Robert Rutt.

DAVIS UPDATE: The hearing scheduled for September 24, 2009 was rescheduled to November 6, 2009 at 9 am. This hearing is to rule on the "Petition to intervene by the Board of Supervisors of Walker Township" filed by the Supervisors on July 23, 2009. This will allow the Township to be actively involved in the hearings.

OLD BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to leave "Reichard Lane" so named as a majority of residents could not agree on another name. Mr. Casner updated the Supervisors on the new Tax Collection committee (Act 32). By November 15 a committee must be set up. Mr. Eyer is looking into the possibility of Juniata County merging with the committee from Cumberland County. Mr. Dreibelbis reported that the grass/trash problems are criminal complaints. The following properties will be pursued through the District Justice Jackie Leister's office: Robert Wright and Ray Leonard.

PARK UPDATE: Mr. Casner reported the backstop, wing walls, and diamond tex has been placed on field 3. Also, the trail from the walking trail to field 3 has been cut and stoned. Mr. Dreibelbis reported construction on the building continues.

NEW BUSINESS: Mr. Dreibelbis reported the new propane tank has been filled for \$1.38 per gallon. He has locked in a price of \$1.50 for 1200 gallons from Heller's. He called around to different propane companies and this was the best pricing. Budget items were discussed. Real Estate and Per Capita taxes will remain the same, however, the street lights will go up to .26 per frontage foot. Insurance reimbursement will go to \$545 per month and \$100,000 will be budgeted for road construction.

SUBDIVISIONS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to approve the Elroy Saner Lot Additions. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the Marlin Frymoyer subdivision. By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the Fred Landis Subdivision.

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 9740 through 9777 and 575 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$1,633.60 was approved for payroll taxes. Also, a hold has been placed on the Chemung Supply Corp check until the road signs arrive.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 9:30 pm.
