

June 7, 2010

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, June 7, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Dreibelbis and Casner were also present. The minutes of the May 3, 2010 meeting were approved as presented.

VISITORS: Mr. Robert Hack. Mr. Hack came to question the reason for his property assessment going up. He added a \$2500 moveable shed to his property but he feels since it is moveable the assessment should not go up. The assessment office follows up on all permits issued by the Township. If the shed is removed from the property, the assessment will be removed for that shed.

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer it was resolved to approve the following permits as issued by Mrs. Saner: Peter Primak, Alma Beward, Harry Durst, Kristopher Wagner, Redbox Automated Retail (Occup), Oscar Supplee (Driveway) and Steven Casner. Mr. Casner abstained.

OLD BUSINESS: Mr. Dreibelbis contacted Steve Manbeck and Tom Metz concerning the set backs for the Juniata Lumber & Supply Inc. development plan. Although the ordinance states no side yard is required with written agreement from all property owners, the Township supervisors requested that at least a 10 foot set back should be in place. The Supervisors cannot enforce this request.

No information was received concerning the Robert Wright property.

PARK UPDATE: Electric has been installed. Work party has been set for June 26, 2010. The Rec Board has requested at least 2 people from each group using the field be present for the day.

NEW BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve an application to join the Federal Surplus Program.

By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to move the State Fund CD to the money market account when it matures (\$30,000)

SUBDIVISIONS: By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following subdivisions: Mervin Zendt and Harvey Petersheim.

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 10007 through 10047 and 583 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$176.88 was approved for payroll taxes.

By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 8:45 pm.
