

July 5, 2010

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, July 5, 2010 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Harry Shearer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Dreibelbis and Casner were also present. The minutes of the June 7, 2010 meeting were approved as presented.

VISITORS: None.

PERMITS: By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as issued by Mrs. Saner: Aaron Peachey, Joe Kanagy, D. Ray Geissinger and Andy Landis.

OLD BUSINESS: Information was received from Mr. Zimmerman concerning the Robert Wright property. A public hearing is scheduled for August 2, 2010 at 6:30 pm at the Walker Township Municipal Building. Mr. Dreibelbis will post the property approximately one week before the hearing.

PARK UPDATE: The work party on the 26th of June consisted of 35 people. They set the foul poles, shaped up field 2, placed engineered wood fibers on the playground, set the spring animal, seeded spots that needed to be reseeded, set the bridge foundation and placed stones around the signs. The building has been painted.

NEW BUSINESS: By motion of Mr. Shearer, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the final completion report for the 2010 road construction project. This will be sent to Penn Dot. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to sign a resolution in "Opposition to forced local government mergers and consolidations (2010-3).

SUBDIVISIONS: None presented.

BILLS: By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the monthly bills with checks 10048 through 10080 and 587 from Mexico Street Light fund. An EFT of \$911.70 was approved for payroll taxes. Check 112 from the State Liquid Fuels fund was approved in the amount of \$45,005.08 to pay for the 2010 construction project.

By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Shearer and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 8:15 pm.
