

April 2, 2012

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, April 2, 2012 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Martin Dreibelbis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Wagner were present. The minutes of the March 5, 2012 meeting were approved as presented.

**VISITORS:** None.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Mr. Dreibelbis researched the right-of-ways widths and in absence of any other documentation the minimum right-of-ways for township roads is 33 feet and 15 ft for township alleys. A letter was sent to Mrs. Leach. The property has been cleaned up and the vehicles have been removed.

**REPORTS:**

**Zoning:** By motion of Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as presented by Shirley Saner: Reine Isham (Driveway and Land Use), Michael Clark (land use), William Bossert (land use), Sam Fleisher (land use), Steven Winey (land use) and Locust Run UM Church (demolition). Requests by possible buyers of the Sherm Shaffer property on East River Road to demolish the house and build a cabin in its place was denied due the fact that is in the flood plain. Joe Deihl's request to erect a cabin in the flood plain but on 15 foot I-Beams was tabled until more information is received.

**Secretary:** Filed payroll taxes, Attended Township, Recreation Board and Executive meetings, Updated Township calendar, letter to Mrs. Leach, updated website, called American Rock salt concerning 2011 contract, bid advertisements, mailed bids...

**Roads:** Mr. Dreibelbis contacted Bill Wilson of Wilson Consulting. He is ready to start the engineering portion of the Red Rock Bridge project.

**Ordinances:** Nothing Reported.

**Finances:** Nothing Reported.

**Park:** Restrooms are open; a water sample was taken (needed to comply with regulations) and contacted DCNR for financial help on the basketball court. Stone is needed around the storage shed at the Mexico field.

**NEW BUSINESS:** By motion of Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to hire Austin Jacobs to mow the Mexico field at the rate of \$10 per hour. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Wagner it was resolved to hire Derrick Casner to work on the road crew at the rate of \$16 per hour. Mr. Casner abstained due to Derrick Casner being a relative.

In order to fulfill the Township's salt contract with American Rock Salt (state contract), one load of salt must be ordered.
