The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, May 7, 2012 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Martin Dreibelbis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisors Casner and Wagner were present. The minutes of the April 2, 2012 meeting were approved as presented.

**VISITORS:** Shirley Hostler.

**OLD BUSINESS:** One load of salt was ordered from American Rock Salt to complete the Township's 2011 – 2012 contract.

**REPORTS:**

**Zoning:** By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Wagner and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as presented by Shirley Saner: Joe Deihl (land use – engineer study received stating the cabin placed on I-Beams is out of the flood plain), Ned Fogleman (land use), Thomas Swailes for Traci Millan (land use), Donald Hess for Van Wert Cheese Shop (land use), Bill Gilson (land use), Robert Walton (land use) and David Gray (land use).

**Secretary:** Filed payroll taxes, Attended Township, Recreation Board and Executive meetings, Updated Township calendar, gathered information and sent same for a Right-to-know project for tax collection, information to resident about plumbing and electrical inspections...

**Roads:** By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Wagner and carried it was resolved to contract with Wilson Consulting Group, PC to engineer construction of the new Red Rock Road Bridge. Mr. Dreibelbis met with Matt Knepp (PennDot) to review the township road names and added the new section of River Rd completed last fall to the liquid fuels inventory. This addition will generate approximately \$110 per year. Also, Short St and Grange Dr do not qualify for the liquid fuel mileage because the cartway must be at least 16 feet.

**Park:** Bathroom cleanings will increase from once a week to twice a week while games are in progress.

**NEW BUSINESS:** By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to use the State Liquid Fuel money to pave Moore and Red Rock Roads. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Wagner and carried it was resolved to apply the 2012 County Aid to this project.

**SUBDIVISIONS:** By motion of Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the Barry Aurand subdivision. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Wagner and carried it was resolved to approve the Gerald Clark subdivision. Juniata County Planning Commission's notes were reviewed and resolved to the supervisors satisfaction.

**BILLS:** By motion of Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the attached monthly bills paid with checks 10811 through 10843 and #606 from Mexico Street Light fund. Also, EFT was approved in the amount of \$1,329.45 for payroll taxes.
