

August 1, 2011

The Walker Township Supervisors met on Monday, August 1, 2011 at the Walker Township Municipal Building for their monthly meeting. Vice Chairman Martin Dreibelbis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Supervisor Casner was present. Supervisor Shearer was absent. The minutes of the July 5, 2011 meeting were approved as presented.

**VISITORS:** Dennis McFarland and Jon Amrhein. Mr. McFarland was present to have the deed transfer signed by the supervisors. This will transfer property on East River Rd to the Township for the purpose of fixing the curve in the road making it easier to navigate. By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis and seconded by Mr. Casner it was resolved to sign the transfer. The Supervisors questioned whether the trees have been planted as required by the Zoning Hearing Board. Mr. McFarland said all trees have been planted and are doing well. They should provide the screening as required. Mr. Casner questioned the cones on River Road. The police had told Mr. Casner they were illegal and dangerous as guests of the campground think it is a crosswalk.

Mr. Amrhein was present to discuss reducing the speed on Rte. 333. Mr. Casner will meet with Penn Dot to discuss the matter.

**PERMITS:** By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to approve the following permits as presented by Shirley Saner: Steve Reinford (land use), Jeff Bashore (land use) and Larry Swartz (land use).

**OLD BUSINESS:** The Palmer Swartz property was sold on 7/22/11. The deed transfer will not take effect until 8/22/11. Mr. Dreibelbis will contact the bank after that date. The workshop meeting for updating the ordinances was held 7/20/11. There have been some modifications to the ordinances but they will have to go to the solicitor and then be advertised before adoption.

**PARK UPDATE:** From July 6, 2011 to August 1, 2011 the following was accomplished: Sand mound was installed, 700 ft of drain in the swales was installed and the men's restroom could be used. Must have the water test done before any water can be used – including the restrooms.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Mr. Dreibelbis attended the Central Juniata EMS board meeting. He received the map outline the CJEMS call area. He would like to appoint someone in that area to the CJEMS board. Also, Mr. Dreibelbis attended the Juniata County Planning Commission meeting at the Brown Fry Building. Discussion was about the Juniata County Subdivision and Land Development ordinance.

**SUBDIVISIONS:** None Presented.

**BILLS:** By motion of Mr. Dreibelbis, seconded by Mr. Casner and carried it was resolved to approve the attached monthly bills paid with checks 10501 through 10523 and 597 from Mexico Street Light fund. Also, approved was \$2,078.32 for payroll taxes. By motion of Mr. Casner, seconded by Mr. Dreibelbis and carried it was resolved to adjourn at 8:40 pm.
